**Subject:- Grant of Extended Permission to Late Babruwan Vitthalrao Kale Ayurved Medical College & Hospital, Z.P. School, Latur-413512, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0188) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 04 seats in 01 PG Course in the subject namely Rachna Sharir under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26-reg.**

Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Late Babruwan Vitthalrao Kale Ayurved Medical College & Hospital, Z.P.School, Gandhi Maidan, Latur-413512, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0188)** inspection was conducted on **08.04.2025 and 09.04.2025 on Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the permission with **60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 04 seats in 01 PG Course in the subject namely Rachna Sharir under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.**
- 2) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024, MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcoming/ defect have been observed:-**

### 1. Teaching staffs:-

a) **Availability of total teaching staff for UG ( BAMS) Course as per the part 1 submitted by the college is**

- 3) **The assessment report was duly placed in the 127<sup>th</sup> Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 20.06.2025 and Board concluded that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations but fulfilling the criteria for issuance of Extended permission in accordance with the Board's policy letter issued on 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025. Hence, the Board decided to issue extended permission in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) Course and 04 seats in 01 PG Course in the subject namely Rachna Sharir in accordance with Regulations 15 (5) of MESAR PG Ayurveda Regulations 2024 as per the provision under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020, for the academic session 2025-26, as the college has been permitted consecutively for previous three years after fulfilling the conditions as specified in the concerned Regulations.**

### **"DECISION"**

- 4) **Therefore, Extended permission is hereby granted to Late Babruwan Vitthalrao Kale Ayurved Medical College & Hospital, Z.P.School, Gandhi Maidan, Latur-413512, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0188) with an intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and 04 seats in 01 PG Course in the subject namely Rachna Sharir Regulations 15 (5) of MESAR PG Ayurveda Regulations 2024 as per the provision under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020, for the academic session 2025-**

26 subject to the conditions that aforementioned shortcomings along with the below mentioned conditions shall be fulfilled:-

- I. **Minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats and minimum 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 04 seats in 01 PG course** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
- II. Determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 5) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 6) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 7) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 8) **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college as per Regulation 55 (2) of MESAR 2024 and the compliance report shall be submitted before 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2025 to be considered for the process of issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
  - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
  - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
  - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
  - iv) The shortcomings mentioned in Para No. 2 shall be fulfilled.
- 9) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.

v) **Deficiencies observed by NCISM:** Deficiencies observed by the NCISM, New Delhi as per Paragraphs 8 (i) to (iv) vide letter mentioned in Sr. No. 2 above may please be fulfilled and a copy of letter to be forwarded directly to NCISM, New Delhi with the copy to the University within prescribed period.


**Important Note:**
